Precinct 4 Canoeing/Kayaking Rules and Regulations

Precinct 4 offers launches at Collins Park, Jesse H. Jones Park & Nature Center, and Pundt Park for those interested in canoeing/kayaking Spring or Cypress Creeks and associated waterways. Please review the following information and submit a completed Canoeing/Kayaking Reservation Form prior to using a launch at a Harris County Precinct 4 location.

- Notice must be given to the Harris County Precinct 4 launch and/or retrieval location **at least 24 hours in advance** of launch for weekday trips. Weekend reservations must be submitted by 3 p.m. on Friday.
- Canoes/kayaks may **not** be launched and retrieved from the same location.
- Please contact Precinct 4 facilities for specific availability/access information.
- Visitors should be aware of the water conditions on their planned date and route.
- All participants are required to adhere to Texas Parks & Wildlife watercraft regulations regarding boating and personal flotation device requirements. For more information, visit www.tpwd.state.tx.us/fishboat/boat/safety/life_jackets.
- Harris County Precinct 4 facilities do not rent canoes/kayaks.
(Tip: *SouthWest PaddleSports* in The Woodlands rents canoes and kayaks)
- It is recommended that all trips begin by noon to ensure completion before the parks are closed. Note: Water levels of the creeks affect the trip times.

Approximate trip durations:

- Collins Park* to the Kuykendahl Road launch at Cypress Creek on the southeast side of the bridge (**3.5 miles**)
- Kuykendahl Road launch at Cypress Creek (on the southeast side of the bridge) to Cypresswood Drive bridge between Treaschwig and FM 1960 (**11.6 miles**)
- Cypresswood Drive bridge (between Treaschwig and FM 1960) to Jones Park*: **4 hours**
- Jones Park* to Edgewater Park (at Hwy. 59 and Hamblen Road): **2 hours**
- Pundt Park* to Jones Park*: **6 hours**
- Riley-Fuzzel Preserve (Montgomery County) to Jones Park*: **8 hours**

(Facilities maintained by Harris County Precinct 4 are marked with an asterisk (). All others are operated by separate entities.)*

- Vehicles remaining at a Harris County Precinct 4 location after hours are subject to towing at the owner's expense.

Completed reservation forms and advance notice of canoe/kayak trips are processed at Jones Park, Pundt Park, and the Parks Reservations Office Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Note: Precinct 4 parks are open every day of the year **except** Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day.
