Supplies:

One Stroke™ complete brush set or equivalent 10-piece brush set
#0 and #2 liner brushes, Robert Simmons or Masters Touch preferred
Wax paper
Tracing paper (small tablet size)
1 sheet of graphite paper
#2 lead pencil
Two blank stencil sheets or clear mylar sheets (to be used as practice sheets)
Water container
Bottle of rubbing alcohol
Floating medium, Folk Art brand recommended
2 Small wooden plaques – 1 oval and 1 rectangle (available in class at wholesale cost)

Additional Information:

The first session is devoted to learning basic brush strokes and how to mix colors using a primary color palette. Other colors will not be required until a project is selected. Americana and Folk Art paint brands are recommended; however, Apple Barrel, Anita's, and Cream Coat are comparable in quality.
