Supplies:

Paints:

Permalba white (large), Mars black, cadimium red (medium), cadimium yellow, ultramarine blue, raw umber, raw sienna, burnt umber, burnt sienna

Note: These need to be 37 mL or 1.25 fluid oz. tubes

Brushes:

One #10 Round

½-inch Angle

#1 Robert Simmons Angle

#0 Brush

Note: These need to be in bristle and not sable.

Cleaning Supplies:

Turpenoid Natural Cleaner

Small glass or metal jar with lid that will seal tightly

Paper towels or clean rags

Apron, old shirt, or old clothes

Palette (Use one of the following: Old plate, plastic disposable tray, piece of glass with taped edges for safety, butcher tray, waxed paper on folded newspapers, or a purchased palette.)

16" x 20" Stretch canvas

Floor or table easel (your choice)

Other supplies:

#4H hard lead pencil

#B2 soft lead pencil

16" x 20" newsprint drawing tablet

Gum eraser

Ruler (preferably an 18", but 12" works)

Scissors

Masking tape

3-ring notebook
