Supplies:

Pigments (one tube of each):

Cadmium yellow light, cadmium yellow deep*, cadmium orange, cadmium red light*, cadmium red, alizarin crimson, cobalt blue, ultramarine deep blue, dioxazine purple* or mineral violet*, viridian, sap green, burnt sienna, ivory black, and yellow ochre

*Optional

Brushes:

Various sizes of bristle fiberts/flats and at least one soft brush for diffusing or #2 round, #3 or #4 fibert bristle, #6 fibert or flat bristle 1½-inch or 2-inch massing brush

Canvas:

11x14 Medium tooth canvas or canvas boards (your choice)
Various sizes according to projects
Primed light gray

Canvas primer:

White gesso
Tube of ivory black acrylic paint (or black gesso)

Palette:

12x16 Masterson lidded palette (has a white base with blue lid)
Disposable palette paper (could also be used)

Medium:

Archival classic (licensed oil is fine)
