### Sewing and Serging

#### Supplies:

Sewing machine\*

**Sewing machine (any brand will do) needs to include the following:**

Straight stitch (general sewing)

Zig-zag stitch (for finishing seams)

Buttonhole stitch or a buttonhole attachment

Blind hem stitch or an attachment

Zipper foot

\*Check with the sewing machine manufacturer about the varied feet and attachments for your machine (or give the model number which is located on the sewing machine.) Check the shank of the press or foot for the height of the shank for proper fit of other feet and attachments for the best results.

Iron (steam preferred) and an ironing board

Cutting tools:

Three sets of 7-9-inch dress maker shears (do not cut paper with these shears)

Small pair of scissors (to snip threads)

Scissors to cut paper (any size will do)

Measuring tools:

36-inch plastic tape

6-inch hem gauge (it is made of metal and the center piece slides back and forth)

36-inch wooden ruler

30-inch portion of tape (to use in small places and neck)

Other tools:

Needles (all three sizes for your sewing machine and a variety of hand sewing needles)

Straight pins (preferable colored heads—the long ones)

Pin cushion

2 rippers

Tracing wheel

Transfer paper

Transfer pencils

Beeswax (for button thread)

Note: Most if these items can be found at any fabric store.
