Silent Hunters

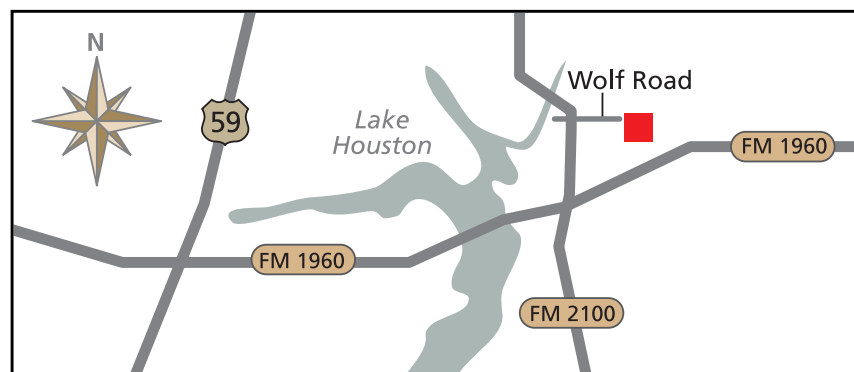
Tuesday, July 21 at 10 a.m.
